### PASTOR'S THOUGHTS

#### Do You Have Time for Jesus?

*Joy to the world! The Lord is come: let earth receive her King.* Let every heart prepare him room

In the month of December we begin our celebration remembering the advent season. As Advent begins, Luke comes to us, as a kind of ghost of Christmas past, bidding us to lay aside for the moment our Christmas lists, leave the half-trimmed tree, pause the holiday movie, dry our hands from washing the cookie pans, and follow him. Suddenly, we find ourselves standing in what we somehow know is a small, ancient Palestinian village on an unusually starry night. The shapes and shadows of buildings look strange. The human and animal noises sound strange. The smoky scents of fire, foods, burning oils, and manure smell strange. The utter absence of electric lighting is strange. We reach for our smartphone. It's dead. Of course I am being humorous but in this short article I just want to draw our attention back to this wonderful story when Christ was born. As we do the story has some different characters and I encourage you to grab your bible and read the story found in Luke.

Do you have time for Jesus? I believe the Christmas story as Luke writes reveals some simple truths in how we make room for Jesus as the song sings "let every heart prepare him room." I will identify the 5 people in the story and how they responded to making room.

- 1. Do you identify with Joseph and Mary? It wasn't easy or convenient, but they made time for Jesus.
- 2. Are you like the innkeeper? They are addicted to activity, not necessarily sinful activity, just things that keep one occupied. Do you not have time for Jesus because you are too busy?
- 3. Maybe you are like Herod. You don't have time for Jesus because you are self-absorbed in you own agenda. Herod is not unlike the men and women today who won't allow anything to interfere with their career, position in life, ambition, plans, or lifestyle. They won't let someone else be king of their lives. They see Jesus as a threat so they don't make time for him. Allegiance to someone else other than themselves is unthinkable.
- Or, perhaps, you most identify with the religious leaders Have you learned yet that familiarity breeds contempt? Your familiar with Jesus, but your heart is covered with calluses. You've heard the story so many times that you don't hear it anymore and you just don't care. Indifferent people ignore their sin and Jesus. They don't care about the remedy because they don't believe they have the disease. So you're saying, "Why bother?"
- 5. The final person is described in this story:
  - A legend recounts a company of demons before Satan's throne. Satan barks in a loud voice,
  - "Who will go to earth to convince people not to give their lives to Jesus".
  - "One said, "I'll go and tell them there is no heaven."
  - "That won't work," Satan protested. "The conviction of a better life is too deep-seated in the hearts of men."
    "Then, I'll go," said another. "I'll tell them there is no hell."
    "Won't work," Satan thundered. "Man's conscience will witness against such mockery."

  - Just then a dark spirit glided forward, "Satan, I'll go."
  - "And what will you tell them?" "I will tell them," answered the spirit, "you have plenty of time to trust in Jesus, tomorrow will be soon enough to give you heart to the Savior. There's no hurry."
